

Astrophotography Workshop with Bill Trevaskis

North Haven is one of the best places in the region to view and capture the sky at night. The lack of light pollution makes it easy to see some of the most amazing details in the Milky Way and beyond, even with the naked eye, but especially with a camera. This three-day workshop will help photographers capture these low-light "nightscares" and get that shot you've always wanted. Focus will be on proper techniques using your camera's full low-light capabilities using long exposures as well as



attention to composition and location scouting. The workshop will consist of two evenings of shooting around the island and one afternoon of editing and critique.

- Flashlight/headlamp
- A bag for all of your gear
- A walking stick if needed; we'll be hiking around in the dark.
